

# STEAMBOAT BIKE PARK



Are you ready for a day in the Steamboat Bike Park?



Riding the Steamboat Bike Park is quite different from your typical mountain bike experience. It's best to use a downhill specific bike, which are designed for the rugged terrain of the Bike Park. Cross-country bikes, while allowed, are not optimal for Bike Park trails and features... Urban/Road style bikes are not allowed within the Steamboat Bike Park.

## Recommendations

- Disc brakes on all wheels
- A minimum of 6" of front and rear suspension travel
- Frame should be designed for aggressive DH riding
- Full face helmets and body protection as shown above
- 12 and under should be accompanied by an adult (the bike school is a great option)

## Not Allowed on Downhill Only Bike Trails:

- No kickstands
- No kick brakes
- Must have a functional brake on each wheel
- No wheels smaller than 16"
- No slick tread urban tires
- Children 5 and under are not permitted within the Bike Park
